CHURCH OVERVIEW

Faith Presbyterian Church (FPC) is a growing congregation in suburban Birmingham with an average worship attendance of 850 between two morning worship services (8:15 and 11:00) and a communing membership of 1,079 and non-communing of 266.

Our congregation meets in Kingdom Communities (KCs) at 9:45 each Sunday. There are eight KCs divided by age and stage of life. Faith also has 63 Grace Groups that meet throughout the week. Grace Groups can be co-ed or single gender and can cover a variety of topics. The Grace Group schedule follows the school calendar and new groups are formed every August.
