Role	Description	Time Commitment	How many needed:
Art Assistant Leader with Sara Marsh	Help the Art Manager, Sara Marsh, oversee art projects that have already been designed.	Flexible hours leading up to Wonderlab to learn the projects, but must be available during Wonderlab	1
Decorations Designer for 2027	There are many volunteers during the week of Wonderlab, and we take advantage of their help to design and create decorations for next year's theme. This volunteer would design decorations and help floaters start making them.	Flexible, but ideally all 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM–12:15 PM	1-2
Art Classroom Leader	Teach and facilitate art projects with rotating groups of children. The art project is already designed for you. There are 1-2 art teachers in a room, and they also have youth helpers as well as support from the class leaders.	-All 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM–12:15 PM -Short training on how to teach the art projects at FPC	12-16
Science Classroom Leader	Facilitate science projects and experiments with rotating groups of children. Diane Pigg creates the projects and teaches the children, and science volunteers help facilitate the projects when the children go into breakout groups.	All 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM–12:15 PM	11
Games	Lead games that have already been planned as groups of children rotate throughout the day.	Flexible, but ideally all 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM–12:15 PM	2
Class Leader	Class Leaders do not teach. They are responsible for up to 12 children and take their group through a rotation of activities (games, science, art) throughout the day. All Class Leaders will have at least one youth helper.	- 1 meeting on a Sunday during KC - All 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM–12:15 PM	26
Floater Leader	We have so many volunteers available at different times that we need a floater leader whom the floaters can report to when they check in to serve each day, and to be a liaison to Jodi/Hannah.	All 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM–12:15 PM	1-2

Floaters	Volunteers who are on standby to help with any kind of specific task. Floaters may be asked to step in as a class leader if they cannot attend at the last minute, or to be in the Science, Art, Game, or snack area to help where needed. Also, prepping decorations for next year's theme.	- 1 meeting on a Sunday during KC - Preferably all 4 days, but flexible attendance for certain days or hours during Wonderlab due to work schedules	25-35
Floater Memory Verse Banner Designer for 2027	Floaters create decorations in preparation for the following year's Wonderlab. We need someone to manage the setup and designs for painting banners throughout the week.	Flexible, but ideally all 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM-12:15 PM	1-2
Check-In/Check-Out Team	Assist with monitoring entrances and managing check-in and station activities. Each child must be checked in at an iPad station upon arrival. During check-out, volunteers help guide parents to form an orderly line, verify security stickers, and facilitate an organized pickup process in the sanctuary.	- 1 meeting on a Sunday during KC -Preferably all 4 days, but flexible for certain days or hours during Wonderlab due to work schedules -These people must come early at 8:15 and stay later until 12:30, but they have flexibility in between	15
Nurse	Be on call for all medical needs.	Flexible but ideally all 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM-12:15 PM	2
Security	Walk around the building and monitor entrances, especially during pick-up	All 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM-12:15 PM	2-4
Parking/Crowd Control	Parking: Help with parking on Monday (2-3) Crowd Control: Assist parents in forming lines during drop-off and pickup at the end of each day.	Flexible but ideally all 4 days, 8:30-9:00 a.m. and 11:45-12:30 p.m.	2-4
Volunteer Thank You	Plan and gather a small gift for our 160+ volunteers (e.g., coupons, snacks, treats).	Flexible time to create and assemble gifts	1-2
Memory Verse Leaders	Get on stage and help lead children in memorizing the week's memory verse with motions (slides prepared for you).	All 4 days of Wonderlab, 8:30 AM-12:15 PM	1-2

Decoration Set Up	Assist with setting up decorations (hanging backdrops, balloon arches, posters, murals, props, photo booth, etc.)	Sunday, June 1 3 hours for flexible time period	15-20
Decorations Prep Team	Assist in making decorations, painting, organizing, preparing t-shirts, etc.	January-March, Wednesday mornings at FPC. Any time between 9–1:00 As many Wednesdays as you can for as long as you are able	10-15
Thursday Clean Up	Help take down all decorations, organize materials back into Wonderlab closet, reset and clean the sanctuary, etc.	Thursday, June 4 12:15–2:00 PM	15-20
Cookout Prep	Set up tables, slice vegetables, wrap burgers, make lemonade, ice drinks, and bring out and refill the food line.	Thursday, June 4 3:30–5:30 or 5:30–7:30	20-30
Cookout Clean Up	Put away all food and cookout materials, drinks, tables, and chairs, wash trays, empty coolers, and take out trash	Thursday, June 5 7:45–9:00 PM	10-20
